Blessed Basil Antony Mary Moreau — The founder of the Congregation of Holy Cross.

The Congregation of Holy Cross joyously celebrates the life of its founder, Blessed Basil Moreau, on January 20th every year. Born in the diocese of Le Mans, France, on February 11, 1799, he would be forever affected by the spiritual upheaval caused by the French Revolution. He founded the congregation of Holy Cross, of Priests, Brothers and Sisters working together as the Holy Family at Nazareth for the salvation of souls. The Cross soon became an integral part of his community's spirituality. The motto of the congregation is Ave Crux, SpesUnica, which means "Hail the Cross, Our Only Hope" — calling on the community to "learn how even the Cross can be borne as a gift." Moreau died on January 20, 1873, and was beatified on September 15, 2007.



OUR LADY OF SORROW

The feast of our Lady of sorrows is the patron feast of the Congregation of Holy Cross. Blessed Basil Moreau's original vision was that the Congregation of Holy Cross be one community of priests, brothers and sisters living and working together in imitation of the Holy Family. As he writes: "She is our special patroness, a woman who bore much she could not understand and who stood fast. To her many sons and daughters, whose devotions ought to bring them often to her side, she tells much of this daily cross and its daily hope" (Constitutions, 8:120). For us, Mary is the perfect model of this hope. Even in the midst of her Sorrows, she never despaired. The Feast of Our Lady of Sorrows is September 15, the biggest feast day for Congregation of Holy Cross priests, brothers and sisters throughout the world. The Holy Cross motto: "Ave Crux, Spes Unica"—"Hail the Cross, Our Only Hope"—reflects the idea of seeing ourselves standing at the foot of the cross alongside Our Sorrowful Mother.

Saint Andre (Bro Andre Bessete, csc) - Friend of the poor, sick and the afflicted.



St. Andre is the first Holy Cross religious to be canonized a saint. Born on August 9, 1845, Alfred Bessette entered the Congregation of Holy Cross in 1870 and took the name Brother Andre. As doorkeeper in one of the Congregation's schools, he fostered devotion to St. Joseph among the sick and otherwise afflicted and soon became known as the "Miracle Man of Montreal." In 1904, he founded a simple shrine that would later become the world-renowned St. Joseph's Oratory. BrotherAndre died on January 6, 1937, and one million persons paid him a last homage. St. Andre was a humble man who gave his life to the Lord and to the people of God, especially to the sick and afflicted. The feast of Bro. Andre is celebrated on the January 6.


